

- Students' tremendous academic pressure <u>results from</u> the competitive education system.



Example:

• <u>Without</u> PE lessons, students will have fewer chances to engage in physical activity; <u>without</u> regular physical exertion, more and more children are doomed to be plagued by deteriorating health; <u>without</u> good health, students will have difficulty concentrating on their studies.

117. V-ed,...; V-ed,...; V-ed,...

Example:
